Assessment Overview

NCCER has developed the Pipeline Training and Assessment Program in partnership with API. PTAP consists of pipeline curriculum and pipeline skill assessments to qualify pipeline personnel under the Department of Transportation's regulation for Pipeline Operator Qualification.

The pipeline assessments are tied directly to NCCER's standardized pipeline curriculum and will determine qualification on selected covered tasks as identified by API and the industry.

Individuals are required to take Abnormal Operating Conditions – Field or Abnormal Operating Conditions – Control Center in addition to the assessment(s) specific to their covered task. All Assessment Tests are closed book and timed. Participants are permitted to use a non-programmable, non printing calculator which is provided by ABC-CCC.
ABC-CCC does not currently offer performance verifications or training for any pipeline assessments.
